**RULES AND DEADLINES**

The Clackamas County Fair Board invites Pacific Northwest Artists, professional and non-professional, to show their original works not previously shown at the Clackamas County Fair, in the Adult Division for artists 16 and older, and the Junior Division, 15 years of age and younger.

- ENTRY DATES:** Works received Friday, August 7, Noon to 8:00 p.m., and Saturday, August 8, 10:00a.m. to 4:00 p.m. **No entries will be accepted after 4:00 p.m. Saturday.** (Upstairs in Main Pavilion). It is requested that exhibitors with numerous entries **MUST BE IN THE DEPARTMENT** at least one hour before entries close.
- All works must be framed or with wrap-around canvas, wired, and ready to hang on peg board hooks. NO sawtooth hangers or exceptions. Attach name, address and telephone number to back of work. The artist should provide special display props, such as pedestals for sculptures.
- Gallery will be open first day of fair, Tuesday, immediately following opening ceremonies. Judge will critique the artwork at 1 p.m.
- Works may be for sale. No commissions are collected
- Every reasonable precaution will be taken in handling entries. However, the sponsors cannot assume responsibility for any loss or damage to works.
- In classes listing “BEST OF SHOW” and “OUTSTANDING RUNNER-UP” Awards, the recipients will be selected from first and second place winners in the various Lots within the Class. SPECIAL AWARDS will be selected at the discretion of the judge.
- RELEASE:** Paintings must be picked up Monday the day following the fair, from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Checks for premiums will be given out by the superintendent as exhibits are released, when possible. **NO CHECKS OR RIBBONS will be mailed.**

Works will be checked out at Art Superintendent’s desk and premiums due will be given out at this time. Paintings will not be released before 2:00 p.m. Monday. No exceptions. Premiums will be withheld and the privilege of showing at future fairs jeopardized by anyone attempting to remove works prior to 2:00 p.m. Monday.

**COMPUTER ART:** Original artwork of artist may be scanned and manipulated by the computer to make final artwork. Paint box or similar program may be used to create graphic work. A mouse, touch pad or stylis pencil may be used to create work. Art works must be framed and ready to hang. **DO NOT USE** computer clip art or pictures taken off the internet or other art banks. Graphic work must be of the artist’s original creation.

**Class 1 ADULT PROFESSIONAL** For professional artists and art instructors.

**ENTRY FEE: \$3.50 per exhibitor (artist), artist may enter up to six works, but not more than three works in any lot.**
