ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per head.

Open Sheep exhibitors will be allowed in the barn Wednesday night **ONLY** after all equipment is removed and cleaning is complete. No tack or setup before this time per the Overall Livestock Superintendent. All entries must be in place by 9:45 a.m. Thursday. Cars will be allowed through the gate until 9:45 a.m. only.

Prior to the showing of any animals, each animal's registration papers **MUST** be checked Thursday, 11:00 am to 4:00 pm in order to show.

PENS WILL BE ASSIGNED. Mark pen space on entry form. Bedding must be furnished by exhibitor. No bedding provided by Fair Board.

All sheep must be registered and Fed tags must be in ears of all Ewes and Rams of all ages to show. Breed Association ear tags must be in place upon arrival at Fairgrounds (Classes 15, 16 & 17 Natural Colored excepted).

At the discretion of the Superintendent, lots with less than three animals will be grouped.

(All classes will be shown in order.)

SPECIAL RULES FOR CLASS 15, 16 & 17 NATURAL COLORED SHEEP ONLY.

Animals entered in Class 15, 16 & 17. Judging will be based 60% on wool, 40% on conformation. Wool judged on color, uniformity of fiber in fleece, absence of cotting and cleanliness.

Fall Lambs 9-1-08 through 1-31-09; Spring Lambs born after 1-31-09.

Shropshire sheep shown slick shorn. Slick shorn is defined as being shorn completely to the hide within five days of the show date. The wool may be left from the rear hocks down and the front knees down plus the wool cap defined as from the ears and poll forward.

Tail Docking: Effective January 1, 1999 market lambs must be docked such that the tail (dock) can be lifted. Lambs that have been re-docked or have complete tail removal will not be eligible. Breeding animals born before January 1, 1999 are exempt. Mid-web should be considered the minimum length.

16. Flock, one yearling or ram lamb, two yearling ewes, two ewe lambs, owned by exhibitor.
17. Best Pair, two animals, any age, bred and owned by exhibitor, both sexes represented.
18. "Best of Show" Ram, all breeds to compete, Trophy.
19. "Best of Show" Ewe, all breeds to compete, Trophy.
20. Go for the Gold.
21. Best Young Flock of Clackamas County.
22. Premier Breeder Award, Rosette. (Refer to General Livestock Rule #19).
