I invite you to participate in the Canby Wine and Art Festival, celebrating its 18th year, June 5-7, 2009. The Festival enjoys a good blend of local wineries and exhibitors. The 2008 Wine & Art Festival noted a 59% increase in attendance over previous years.

We will again be opening on Friday evening for a special evening of romance! Internationally recognized musician Patrick Lamb will perform under the stars while patrons enjoy wine, gourmet food and special evening events. Saturday and Sunday will include music from a variety of entertainers including: Portland's 2008 Female Vocalist of the year Debra Arlyn, Brady Goss and the Touchables!

New this year:

- We are partnering with The Wilsonville Inn and Suites to provide room packages, which will include shuttle service to and from the Festival.
- Juried Art Gallery: This year our goal is to acquire more art exhibits. A gallery has been established for the event in the Annex of the Main Pavilion for all exhibitors who purchase a booth space. Each artist may submit one piece of art in up to 3 of the following categories: Painting, Sculpture, Drawing, Printmaking, Fiber, and Photography. During our special Friday evening event, patrons will select their favorite pieces of art. One piece of art in each of the above categories will be honored with the award. The selected People's Choice artists will receive a plaque or ribbon for their booth, as well as a ribbon displayed with their art in the gallery. All People's Choice Awards will be posted on the Wine & Art Festival website and post-event press materials. While your artwork will be for sale in the gallery (unless otherwise specified by the artist), artwork may not be removed from the Gallery until 5:00 PM Sunday evening. Only the submitting artist or their previously arranged designee will be allowed to remove artwork from the gallery.

I are very excited about this event, and the opportunity to provide a fabulous wine and art experience for our patrons, as well as you, our exhibitors.

Sunday, June 7th, 11:00am – 5pm
- Gate Fees:** \$5.00 Admission, Children 12 & under Free
- Discount:** Saturday and Sunday from 11:00AM to 1:00PM
Admission Discount – 2 for the Price of One
- Passes:** Exhibitors will have four (4) identification badges per booth for Festival workers. Additional badges are available for \$5.00 each when purchased before the Festival
- Products:** **Only items on your 2009 Permit Product Agreement will be accepted.**
Please contact me if you wish to add or change any items.
- We provide:** Eight foot drapery on the back of your booth, 3 foot drapery on the sides, one 6 foot skirted table for inside and porch spaces. Outside spaces include one six-foot table and chairs. Let me know if you need additional equipment.
- Booth Appearance:** Booth spaces should be attractive and professional in appearance. Your presentation will reflect upon your products and the Festival as a whole. For example: we suggest using linen tablecloths, professional signage and appropriate props and decorative items. Attention to detail will help ensure a successful weekend for everyone. You need to bring your own fixture for hanging your work on. Please be considerate of your neighbor and do block them with your fixtures along the sides of the booth.
- Electricity:** If electricity is needed, please list what kind of service you will need on the agreement.
- Parking:** Parking permitted across the street from the entrance to the Main Pavilion. The front of the Main Pavilion is for loading and unloading only.
- Move-In:** Friday, June 5th 11:00AM to 4:00PM. Contact me if you need to make other arrangements.
- Move-Out:** No vendor will be allowed to begin tear down or move out process until 5:00 PM sharp Sunday, June 7th. Parking is free during the event.
- RV Parking:** There is RV Space available at the fairgrounds for \$15.00 with hook-up per night, \$10.00 without hook up per night. Pay to the Clackamas County
